

Phoenix 2009 – Protein Complexes in Signalling and Development Update and Delegates' Information

Change of venue!! All events for the Phoenix 2009 Symposium will now be held within the **Bower Building of the University of Glasgow**, including registration, all catering, posters and the four oral session. Hosting the Symposium under one roof greatly simplifies our logistics and should make for a more relaxed meeting generally. The Bower Building is located at the Botany Gate, at the junction between of University Avenue and University Place, and approximately 3-min walk from the Hillhead underground station.

Registration (in the main foyer of the Bower Building) will open 15:00-19:00 on Thursday, 25th June, and 08:30-12:00 and 15:00-17:00 on Friday, 26th June.

Sessions will run on Thursday evening, Friday morning and afternoon, and Saturday morning. The session programme is attached and is also available on the Phoenix web site.

Catering. Breakfasts for those booked in Queen Margaret Halls and Cairncross House will be in the Bower Building, available from 08:00-08:45 Friday and Saturday mornings. The Welcome Buffet will be available for all delegates in the Bower Building venue from 17:30 onwards on Thursday. Friday evening we encourage you to explore the numerous restaurants, cafes and pubs nearby. A list of our favourites will be available at the Symposium.

Accommodation for those booking single rooms with us is in the Queen Margaret Halls by the Botanic Gardens and approximately 15 min walk to the Bower Building. For those booked with us in double rooms, you are accommodated in Cairncross House, located near the junction of Sauchiehall Street and Kelvin Way, and will have a 10 min walk to the Bower Building. Check-in will be available at the main desks of Queen Margaret Halls and Cairncross House from 14:00 onwards on the first day of your booking.
